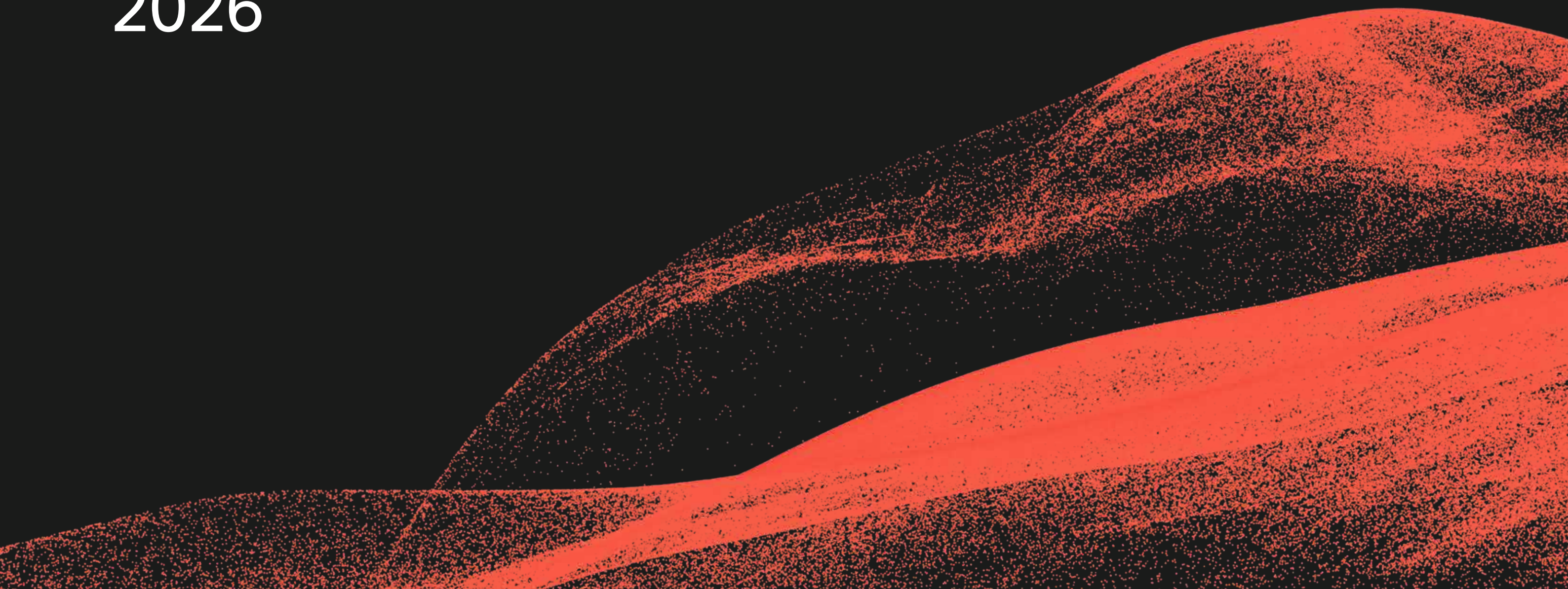

This theory has been widely replicated across the world and in India. The Niti Aayog a body of Government of India, narrowed from aspirational districts to 500+ aspirational blocks based on the 39 development indicators to make a wholistic development of a society and for equitable growth in areas such as (i) Education, (ii) Environment, (iii) Empowerment and (iv) Health & Nutrition. With the past experiment & following success of such an integrated development approach in the Dang District, Gujarat, we now wish to replicate the model in partnership with Niti Ayog & district administration in select gram panchayats. This wholistic approach of transformation of rural communities will be undertaken over a period of 4 years, the first three years being implementation years and the fourth year being the graduation year to exit out of the area successfully and sustainably by handing over the best practices to the local management. In addition, institutional building of community-based organizations will ensure second line of defence for self-sustenance of the initiatives without creating dependency beyond 48 months of project implementation period.
